

CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR-2020 (SEPTEMBER SESSION)

Cooperation with the Erasmus + Higher Education Program of the European Union

1. Erasmus Mundus Master's Degree in Mechatronic Engineering, offered jointly by the following European institutions of Higher Education:
 - University of Oviedo (Spain)
 - Hochschule Karlsruhe – Technik und Wirtschaft (Germany)
 - École Nationale Supérieure de Mécanique et des Microtechniques (France)
 - Nile University (Egypt) and Ivanovo State Power Engineering University (Russian Federation)

2. The Joint Master Program has been selected by the Executive Agency of Education, Audiovisual and Culture of the European Commission (EU-EACEA) to be taught from 2019/2020 and beyond, and the University of Oviedo (Spain). Pokhara University is Participating, according to our own criteria and possibilities, in the activities of the Master through:
 - Collaboration of Pokhara University lecturers in the teaching of the program at the European universities using the Erasmus scholarships available for the teaching staff.
 - Facilitation of internships for master students.
 - Co-supervision of student theses.
 - Promote the Erasmus program among the students of Pokhara University so that they can receive European Erasmus student grants and come to Europe to attend the program.
 - Others (share research projects, etc.)

3. The Pokhara University and the Erasmus Mundus Master Consortium on Mechatronic Engineering signed the appropriate agreement to fully regulate the cooperation of the parties.

Eligibility criteria for PU for recommendation:

For staff: Permanent staff having 3 years of service as academic staff

For Students: Minimum CGPA=3.5 out of 4
