Respiratory diseases: Tuberculosis, SARS, Acute Bronchitis, Bronchial Asthma, Chronic Obstructive Airway Disease, Pneumonias, Bronchogenic Carcinoma, Bronchiectasis, Pleural effusion, Pneumothorax, COVID-19, Post COVID syndrome, Occupational Lung Diseases.

Acid Peptic Diseases, Cirrhosis of Liver and ascites, Hepatitis, Hepatic Encephalopathy, Pancreatitis,

Blood and Lymphoreticular Diseases: Anaemia, Pancytopenia, Purpura, Agranulocytosis, Polycythemia, Lymphomas, Myeloma, Hemoglobinopathies.

Neurological Diseases: Meningitis, Encephalitis, Epilepsy, Cerebro-Vascular Disease, Motor Neuron disease, Coma , Headache, Cerebral Malaria , Parkinson's Disease, Paraplegia, Multiple Sclerosis, Myasthenia Gravis, Neuro-cysticercosis, Bell's palsy, GBS, Neurosyphilis, Headache, Spina Bifida, Neurogenic Shock.

Endocrine and Metabolic Diseases: Diabetes Mellitus and related complications, Disorders of Thyroid/parathyroid/pituitary/ adrenal glands and gonads, Metabolic syndrome, Obesity.

Joint, Musculoskeletal and Connective tissue Diseases: Rheumatoid Arthritis, Gout, Anykylosing Spondylitis, Duchene Muscular Dystrophy, Osteogenesis imperfecta, Systemic Lupus Erythematosus

Tropical Diseases: Leprosy, Filariasis, Malaria, Kala-azar, Dengue, Tuberculosis, Cholera, Enteric Fever, scrub typhus, Leptospirosis, Tetanus, Amoebiasis, Mumps, Snakebite, Rabies, Insect bite, Scorpion Bite, Chikungunya

Renal disease Acute kidney injury, chronic kidney Disease, Glomerulonephritis, Acid Base disturbance, Electrolyte disturbances, Urinary Tract infection

- **2. Psychiatry:** Emotional Disorders (Anxiety, depression, sleep disturbance), Neurosis, Psychosis and Psychosomatic Disorders. Eating disorders, Mass Conversion Disorder, Cognitive Behavioral Therapy Substance abuse.
- **3. Dermatology and STD:** Urticaria, Scabies, Dermatophytosis, Herpes Simplex, Herpes Zoster, Psoriasis, Lichen Planus, Pemphigoid, Pemphigus, Drug Eruption, Acne vulgaris, Molluscum contagiosum, Skin malignancies, seborrheic dermatitis and HIV/AIDS including Universal Precaution.

Emergency Medicine:** Multiple traumas including blunt abdominal injury, Hemoptysis, hematemesis and melena, RTA, Trauma, drowning, Poisoning, Insect bite, Snake bite, Catheterization, NG Tube Insertion, Burn, Bullet injury. Management of Acute poisoning and Coma Acute pain abdominal & chest, Status Epilepticus and Acute severe asthma, Breathlessness, Epistaxis, Vaginal bleeding and Shock including anaphylaxis.
