The language of publication is English, typed in Cambria, 10 font size and APA Style of "citation and referencing. Please submit your manuscript in the following address by 17 October 2023. Following is the Guidelines for Authors for the preparation and submission of the manuscript.

Guidelines for Authors

The *Journal of Development and Social Engineering* (ISSN: 2382-5332) is a publication of the School of Development and Social Engineering, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Pokhara University. The guidelines for submission of articles in the Journal of Development and Social Engineering are as follows:

- 1. Articles for submission must be in English. They must be original and not previously published nor in the process of publication in any other journal either in printed or in electronic form.
- 2. Submission must include a cover page containing the title of the article, the name of the author(s), institutional affiliation (not more than three levels) of each author, and Email of the corresponding author, an abstract with not more than **250 words**, and at least four, but not more than six keywords. The other pages must not contain the name or other identification of the author(s).
- 3. Article should start with an abstract and should proceed with Introduction, Data and Methods, Results and Discussion, and Conclusion followed by Acknowledgements, References and Appendix.
- 4. Manuscripts should be limited to **7000 words** including illustrations, graphs, and charts and typed with single space, printable in A4 paper, using **Cambria**, 10 fonts size and **APA Style** of citation and referencing. Tables, graphs, charts, maps and other illustrations should be prepared in any size which should be able to readjust as necessary. If fixed size, the maximum size of tables, diagrams, maps etc. should be limited to **8 (H) * 5.75 (L) inches**. Manuscript must be free of external hyperlink.
- 5. Author(s) are requested to strictly follow point 1 through 4, above.
- 6. A soft copy of the article should be submitted by Email.

- 7. The submitted article will checked to its broad field of coverage, components and format, if not found congruent it will be sent back to the author(s) for the needful. If found congruent the article will undergo through a blind submission policy and will be anonymously reviewed by experts and further comments will be sent for improvement. The right to select any article is reserved to the Editorial Board, based on the comments of experts.
- 8. A second round of comments, if deemed necessary by the Editorial Board, may be provided to the author(s) with a week of extended time.
- 9. The author(s) will be accountable for the content and referencing, including plagiarism matters for his/her/their article(s) and, therefore, the article(s) published in the Journal of Development and Social Engineering will not reflect the principles or policies either of the School of Development and Social Engineering, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Pokhara University or the Editorial Board of JDSE.
- 10. The decision of the Editorial Board will be the final.
